Be it resolved that council hereby approve the following Employee Benefit clarification: Overtime pay to be calculated on actual time worked after 50 hours/summer or 45 hours/winter; Sick leave not considered in the calculation of overtime pay.

Ex: If employee works 10 hours of overtime from Monday to Thursday and then takes 5 hours on Friday for Doctor's appointment – he would get 5 hours at 1.5 overtime and 5 hours at regular time to compensate for the 5 hours of sick benefits.
